DIVERSION ORDER 2017**

On the 28th March 2019, the Gloucestershire County Council confirmed the above Orders made under Section 118 and Section 119 of the Highways Act, 1980, and Section 53(a)(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert and extinguish lengths of public footpaths MBL 8 and MBL 9 as described in Part I of the Schedule hereto to the line described in Part II of the said Schedule and the Definitive Map and Statement will be modified accordingly.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and plan annexed to the Order ('the Order Plan') may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, GL1 2TG, and at Stroud District Council, Council Offices, Ebley Mill, Stroud Glos GL5 4UB. Copies of the Order and Order Plan may be obtained free of charge (please quote reference MBL8/9/MBT).

The Order comes into force on the 28th March 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the power of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirements of the Act, or of any regulations made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published, apply to the High Court..
