



**EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE  
41302 FAIRVIEW TO THE OLD MILL ROAD (BISLEY WITH LYPIATT  
PARISH) STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has by this emergency notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of the 41302 Fairview to The Old Mill Road, know locally as Rebecca's Hill from outside the entrance to a property known as Spring Hollow to outside the entrance to a property known as Croft's Hill for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

The road falls within Bisley with Lypiatt Parish in the Stroud District, Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary due to a crumbling stone wall affecting trees and blocking the road and has become dangerous.

The road was originally closed for 21 days by notice commencing 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020. However, as the works to remedy the problem have not been completed it is necessary to extend the closure by notice for a further 21 days commencing 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020, after which it will be necessary to make an Order.

This Order would authorise the closure of the road for up to eighteen months from the date of the first Notice

Pedestrian access will be maintained. However, emergency access is not possible as machinery and essential materials will be blocking the road to traffic.
